DIANE: is going to write a piece on the website about why we need the £900 and how people can contribute. She will also write a short piece on advice for traders.

IAN: is going to investigate publicity avenues, Hackney Today etc

JACQUI & VENETIA: are going to start putting together the outline for a business plan, which will start to look at how the market can become cost neutral in the long-term
